

1) Before You Apply

1. **Attend Study Abroad Information Session (Mandatory).**
2. **Research** your options.

2) Application Process

1. Download **Main Application** from TRU Study Abroad web site – Bilateral or ISEP.
2. Print and complete either a Bilateral or ISEP Application – following all checklist items
3. **Make an appointment** to see Study Abroad Manager by contacting Vicky Gold at vgold@tru.ca or calling 250-828-5164 (**Mandatory**).

3) Acceptance Process

1. **TRU Study Abroad** will **notify** you of your acceptance into the program.
2. **Application forwarded to host institution** for approval by TRU Study Abroad.
3. **Patience** Is needed! It can take weeks or sometimes months to hear back from host institutions.
4. **Acceptance letter** from host – once received, you can contact regarding housing, courses, and orientation information.
5. Application to your host government consulate for **resident/student visa** (A visa is an approval inserted into your passport).

NOTE: Submitting an application without attending an Information Session will likely result in an unsuccessful application.
